



MAKE A PAPER BOAT OUT OF A SHEET OF A4 PAPER

(it helps if you make this on a flat surface)





Fold A4 paper in half lengthways & make a crease along the centre. Then open out again.





Fold in half again (but this time along the width).





With the fold at the top, turn down the corners to meet the creased line.





Fold the bottom flap up on one side – then turn over and turn down the small corners, before turning up the front flap.





Tricky bit!
Pull out the centres (where the arrows are shown), twist & flatten.





Fold front lower half up at the centre, turn over and repeat on the other side.





Another tricky bit! Pull out the sides (where the arrows in this picture are shown), twist & flatten.

From the tip, gently pull the two sides apart to reveal the boat shape.

Flatten out the boat, making sure to crease the two sides of the base to make a sturdy hull.

Flatten out the sail & see if your boat floats!
